Players must be Alabama Residents and must be in the correct grade range to play in the HS, JH, and Elementary Championships. Must have a current or recent rating that is at or above the cut-off rating.*
Nominees to the Denker, Barber, and Rockefeller tournaments will be chosen from these sections.

4 Rounds Swiss, Game/45, d5. Round Times: 9:30, 12:15, 2:15, 4:00

The remaining sections, including the Primary Championship, are restricted by grade range but are open to players from other states. Rating restrictions apply to all "under" sections.

MEMBERSHIPS REQUIRED: This is a US Chess rated tournament. **US Chess membership is required.** (Obtain or renew at www.uschess.org.) **Alabama Chess Federation membership is required** for all Alabama residents. (Obtain or renew at www.alabamachess.org.)
